GENERAL FLIGHTING INFORMATION

1. PARTICIPANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY IN ANY DIVISION OUTSIDE THEIR AGE GROUP.
2. Participants are expected to have previous tournament experience, know the rules of golf, walk the course, and carry their own clubs. CADDIES ARE NOT ALLOWED.
3. Participants are expected to make all course management decisions; coaching, counseling or consultation is forbidden.
4. Participants will be flighted on day one based on the following information:
 - o Handicap or average score information listed on the entry form.
 - o Previous scoring information acquired by youth's participation in prior tournament.
 - o Whenever handicap or scoring information cannot be verified youth will be flighted with juniors with the least golfing experience.
5. Participants must qualify on Saturday for Sunday's competition. They must score 108 or less, on Saturday, to remain a part of Sunday's competition.
6. On Sunday *qualifying* youth will be flighted according to their age and scores from day one.
7. Juniors scoring 109 or more, on Saturday, will compete in a separate 9-hole contest on the Kitty Course. The scores earned on Sunday will determine the results of that contest.

Beginners -- NO Beginner's Flight; see rule 2, above.

Youngsters -- Ages 8 – 11 – Will consist of the following age groups: 8 – 9, & 10 – 11. These Youngsters are expected to play 9 holes each day, carry their own clubs, and walk the 9 holes.

Juniors -- Ages 12 – 17 – Will consist of the following age groups: 12 – 13, 14 – 15, & 16 – 17. These Juniors will play 18 holes each day, carry their own clubs, and walk the 18 holes.

Collegiates -- Ages 18 – 23 – Collegiate players will play 18 holes each day. Females will play from the *white* tees and males from the *championship* tees. All will walk the course and carry their own clubs.

SPECIAL NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS/COACHES

Parents/guardians/coaches are not permitted to keep official scores for their participant's foursome.

Parents/Guardians/Coaches are not permitted to counsel or coach participants. If you walk with your participant's group you must remain silent and maintain a distance of fifty (50) feet. Persons who break the above stated rules may be asked to leave the golf course. Participants may be disqualified if parents/guardians/coaches cause infraction(s) of this rule.

CARTS MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE TO PARENTS/COACHES IF THE COURSE HAS NEED OF THEM

NO ON SITE REGISTRATION. ALL REGISTRATION WILL BE HANDLED BY MAIL. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY FULL PAYMENT. Make checks/money orders/ purchase orders payable to Greater Dayton Youth Golf Academy. Clubs or organizations wishing to register groups of youth should send a check/money order/purchase order from the organization/city/governmental entity responsible for payment.

Entry Deadline: Entry Deadline is June 22, 2007; entries postmarked after this date will be returned to sender.

Confirmation of Entry: **Application confirmations will be mailed to entrants and postmarked no later than July 6, 2007.**

Equipment: All golfers must have their own golf clubs, bag tees and balls. NO METAL SPIKES ALLOWED and NO CARTS ALLOWED.

Dress Code: NO BAGGY/SAGGY PANTS OR SHORTS – CUT OFFS – TANK TOPS – SHORT SHORTS – JEANS – BIKER SHORTS – SWEAT SUITS or JOGGING SUITS are to be worn by tournament participants. Collared Shirts are to



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be worn tucked inside. Pants and shorts are to be worn belted at the waist. Hats and caps are to be worn correctly. Club/Organization Tee shirts acceptable; all others discouraged, any deemed offensive will be barred.

Curfew: Participants must be in their hotel *rooms* by 11 pm each evening. Please be out of the hallways. Visiting from room to room after curfew is forbidden. Breaking curfew is grounds for automatic tournament disqualification.

Profanity: Participants are expected to refrain from the use of profanity. The use of profanity will be reason for automatic tournament disqualification. *Meal on Sunday:* Participants will be entitled to a meal at the end of play on Sunday. Tickets will be given to participants when their scorecard is turned in. Parents/coaches, etc. may purchase the meal.

Pledge: Signatures are required for all participants. Parent's signatures are required for participants under the age of 18.
